Because of extremely heavy demands on our time and facilities we are reducing the amount of our propagation. We have never, and do not now intend to be a "big" nursery. The increasing demand on our time has prevented us from enjoying our private life and has interfered with our enjoyment of the study of maples. We find this unacceptable. Therefore, our plant list is reduced this year. Although costs have risen, we have kept prices the same or reduced them in some cases.

Most of the cultivars listed are in limited supply. PLEASE list substitutes if you wish. Our aim is to continue to supply limited numbers of the rare, dwarf, unusual and "new" cultivars and species of exotic maples. Many cultivars are becoming available elsewhere.

Custom propagation: For those who do not find a specific cultivar or species listed this year, we will do a LIMITED amount of custom propagation. Send the request for specific items not available elsewhere, and we will propagate to your order. NO large quantity orders, please.

For the specialist, collector, arborist, and avid horticulturist: We occasionally propagate almost all items in our collection of 400 cultivars, species, and varieties. We never have enough of many of these items to put on the sales list. If you are seeking certain cultivars or species, send your want items. We may have them.

Prices and shipping: Prices indicated are for one-year grafts. When two-year grafts are desired, the price is \$5.00 per plant over the 1-year price. Two and three year old plants are not always available. Prices are F.O.B. Roseburg, Ore. Shipping costs will be sent with the bill. We ship by (Air) Blue Label U.P.S. whenever possible. Shipping is done during our dormant season from late October to March 1. Plants are packed with bare roots in plastic sleeve in special containers.

We present this seed list in response to numerous requests for small samples of seed. It is designed for the horticultural collectors, hobbyists, bonsai enthusiasts, and arborists. We do not market trade packets for commercial producers.

All seed is Fall 1980 crop from stock plants proved to have viable seed. However, since we ship to a great number of people with a wide variety of methods of handling, storing, pre-treatment, planting, and growing, we cannot guarantee germination or survival. We send the best possible seed but will not replace seed failing to germinate.

PRICES: All packets are \$1.50 each, postpaid. The number of seed per packet will vary: rare species and/or cultivars may have as few as 6 seeds per packet; less rare types may have from 12 to 25 or more seeds each.

PLEASE NOTE: Cultivars and varieties of Japanese Maples (*Acer palmatum*) do not normally come true to the cultivar name but will often vary greatly in the types of seedlings germinated. For example: planting dissectum (Laceleaf) seed will not necessarily produce seedlings of the dissected type. There is a good chance that a few - or many - dissectums will be produced. Many will be the normal "type" palmatum species. Likewise, when seed from "red" cultivars is planted, a certain percentage will be red but many will be green. The shape of the seedling leaves will vary considerably with the various cultivars. Seedlings should never be judged for real character until at least the second growing season.

The species seed listed can be expected to be true to type.

Pre-treatment and planting instructions will be included with the seed packets.

All the cultivars of "Japanese Maples" as well as the species from Japan will be found described in the new book, JAPANESE MAPLES by J. D. Vertrees.
