All prices are F.O.B. our nurseries - Spring City, Pa. (Snowdenville) and Media, Pa., subject to our confirmation of order.

TERMS:

All accounts - 30% cash with order; balance (at time of pickup) by Bank Cashier's Check or Cash. This is in no way a reflection on your Firm but a protective measure for Red Maple Nurseries since we have suffered many losses due to bad checks.

LATE PAYMENT:

Interest charge on overdue accounts (30 days from date of pickup invoice) computed at 1-1/2% per month (18% annual rate).

PENNSYLVANIA CUSTOMERS:

6% Pa. Sales Tax will be added to your invoice unless we receive a Pa. Sales Tax Exemption Certificate prior to billing your order.

PICKUPS:

We will notify you by phone when your order is ready. You must notify us at least 48 hours before pickup of trees. Pickups are handled Mondays through Fridays between 10 A.M. and 12 P.M. and 1:00 P.M. to 3:00 P.M. NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS SCHEDULE. The trees become your property upon delivery to carrier and we cannot be responsible for loss, damage, or delay in transit. We will supervise loading to give maximum protection to trees. IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO PROVIDE NECESSARY TARPS, COVERS, ROPES, ETC. TO PROTECT THE TREES FROM DRYING OUT WHILE TRAVELING FROM OUR NURSERY TO YOUR LOCATION. It is advisable to send your own enclosed truck, if possible, on orders of this nature. Open trucks MUST BE COVERED when hauling deciduous trees. If trees are damaged because sufficient protective cover was not provided by you, then we cannot accept any responsibility of complaints concerning condition of trees on arrival. All shipments travel at risk and cost of purchaser. NO GUARANTEE ON ORDERS BEING HELD IF NOT PICKED UP WITHIN TWO WEEKS AFTER NOTIFICATION OF READINESS. NURSERY LOCATIONS:

The Media, Pa. nursery is located 15 miles west of Philadelphia, Pa. and 2 miles west of Media, Pa. The nursery is located just off Route 1 on Route 352 North, near the Granite Run Mall.

Activities at the Media nursery are Container Grow, Retail Sales, Research and Development of new and rare trees and Propagation.

About 6,000 cv. EMPEROR I (tm) Japanese maples are being grown on this site.

Bloodgood trees ranging from 5' to 10 or 11" constitute the bulk of the Snowdenville trees.

Large trees (12', 14', 18') of Oshio Beni, Bloodgood, Palmatum Green Littleleaf and some large Japonicums are on this site. CONTAINER DISSECTUMS:

We have a good supply of 2, 3 and 5 gallon dissectums at our Media, Pa. nursery. These trees are red and green cultivars. Span sizes range from 2-1/2' to 5'. Prices range from \$25.00 to \$100.00 with a few at \$145.00.

FIELD GROWN DISSECTUMS: (**)

SPAN SIZES RANGE FROM 3-1/2' TO 8' AND EACH TREE IS INDIVIDUALLY PRICED. Trees require three days under our fog mist system before pickup. We dig March through July. We do not dig in August but resume digging in mid-September through November.

We have over 300 of these field grown dissectums in many different cultivars - both red and green. Some of the cultivars are Garnet, Green Mist, Nigrum, Oregon Everred, Ornatum, Tamukeyama and Waterfall.

DIGGING: (**) This applies to upright and dissectum trees. If a tree cannot be dug by a 44" Vermeer, it must be hand dug at an additional charge. For these larger trees, we charge an hourly rate which will be discussed with customer.

RARE TREES -- FROM THE PRIVATE COLLECTION OF CAROLYN AND RICHARD WOLFF, MEDIA, PA. AND SNOWDENVILLE, PA.

We have been adding to our collection since 1969 with visits to Henry Hohman of Maryland and heavy contributions by Professor J. D. Vertrees (Deceased) of Oregon, accounted for many fine new cultivars. Dozens of collectors have participated in building this collection.

Skip March of U.S.D.A. has been most generous in the exchange of Japanese maple cultivars. Dave Patterson (Deceased) of Longwood Gardens exchanged dozens of cultivars including Hilliar (Knight) of England introducing new cultivars from Kew Gardens in England.

Our collection is a PRIVATE COLLECTION and, at best, it is difficult to protect, test and maintain. Recording of the data on each tree is extremely time consuming. Despite all security measures, some theft has occurred over the years.

From time to time, exchange of scions has been in order but in more recent years, it has been almost impossible to fill the many requests of collectors.

The response to the article on Japanese maples in June/July issue of FINE GARDENING has been overwhelming. We have received hundreds of requests for the brochure - many with information requests - plus numerous telephone calls from all sections of U.S.A. including Hawaii, Alaska and a few from Canada.

Our entire collection of rare Japanese maples is being reworked and repotted (in pulp pots) in August and September of this year - pruned in February 1994 after which many will be available for sale in May and June of 1994. We recommend planting the tree in the pulp pot. We have done this for many years with no side effects. You will be advised when these trees will be ready for sale.

NOTE:

We must maintain at least two stock trees of all cultivars for the preservation of the collection.

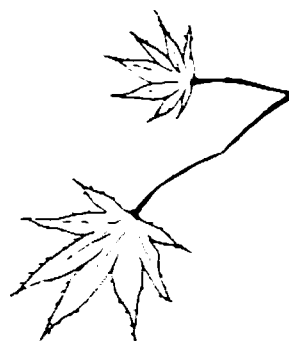
